

## Looking for F.A.T. Men



### I. How Do We Pass On Our Faith to the Next Generation?

- A. Our faith was never designed to die with us.
  - 1. How do we prepare our children to their faith?
  - 2. Are our young people prepared to face life?
  - 3. Paul gives to Timothy the formula for success.
- B. There was a strong exhortation to stand strong.  
***“Be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus”.***
  - 1. Paul already knew the challenges that were ahead.
  - 2. It was now Timothy’s time to run the race.
- C. God has always looked for the right kind of man.
  - 1. David was a man after His own heart. **1 Samuel 16**
  - 2. Who will stand in the gap for God? **Ezekiel 22**
  - 3. Timothy was to look for some F.A.T. men.

### II. What Kind of Man is God Looking for Today?

- A. The Lord is looking for men who are **FAITHFUL**.
  - 1. A faithful man is someone who can be trusted.
  - 2. Timothy was to find men who were reliable.
  - 3. We need men today who are faithful to the Lord.
- B. Our God needs men who are **ABLE** to be taught.  
~ ***1 Thessalonians 1:6-8***
  - 1. Men must be willing to accept God’s word.
  - 2. Timothy, himself, was able to be taught by Paul.
  - 3. No one person knows everything, but God does.
- C. We need men who will **TEACH** others!  
~ ***Acts 18:24-28***
  - 1. Apollos was an eloquent & knowledgeable man.
  - 2. Aquila & Priscilla taught him more accurately.
  - 3. He was then better equipped to teach others.

### III. Conclusion: A Call to Repentance .....

- A. What keeps us from being F.A.T. men?
    - 1. Sin will keep a good man unfaithful.
    - 2. Our transgressions will make our hearts hard.
    - 3. ***Let not many of you become teachers.***
  - B. Are we wanting to save face or souls?
    - 1. Our task is to seek & save those who are lost.
    - 2. We must be more concerned about our task.
  - C. **The Lord calls us to Godly Sorrow!**
    - 1. Godly sorrow leads us to repentance.
    - 2. Godly sorrow leaves us with no regret.
