

Refined by Fire



I. Introduction: The Christ-like Walk is a Life of Praise.

- A. Do we enjoy a life of praise?
 - 1. Our praise is not limited to Sunday morning.
 - 2. We have a "new birth into a living hope.".
 - 3. We have a living Savior and a great inheritance.
- B. We praise God because of His great protection.
 - 1. He shields us by His power through our faith.

- 2. He protects us during our fiery trials.
- 3. Our shield of faith protects us from Satan.
- C. Our lives are filled with praise because of Jesus.
 - 1. Our faith in Christ will be proved genuine.
 - 2. We are receiving the goal of our faith. (1:9)
 - 3. Jesus will be revealed in the end.

II. Body: How is our Faith Refined by Fire?

- A. Our faith is tested through the trials we endure.
 - 1. Satan will send flaming arrows at us to hurt us.

- 2. The enemy sent Paul a thorn in the flesh.
- 3. The devil does not want to refine us.
- B. Our faith protects us from the power of sin.
 - 1. When we are filled with His Spirit, we are very powerful people. ~ *Luke 11:24-26*
 - 2. We must fill our lives with more Jesus.
- C. Our faith is proved genuine when refined by fire.
 - 1. Others may not benefit when our faith is tried.
 - 2. God already knows how strong we are.
 - 3. We benefit the most from the trials.

1 Peter 1:3-7

III. Conclusion: What Can We Learn from Peter?

- A. We are valuable in the eyes of God.
 - 1. The Lord compares our faith to gold.
 - 2. He is strengthening our faith.
- B. There is a reason for the trials that we face.
 - 1. The Lord may be teaching us through trials.
 - 2. We must remain patient, attentive & alert.
- C. Trials are temporal, but heaven is eternal.
 - 1. We all look forward to the restoration.
 - 2. We must always live in hope.
